Vaccinations: Your dog must be on a flea preventative program or free of fleas, be free of parasites, and be current on the following vaccinations to attend Doggy Town: canine parvovirus, canine distemper, infectious canine hepatitis, Leptospirosis and Bordetella (kennel cough), optional but highly suggested. Before your dog can attend its first day we will need to see documentation from your vet regarding these requirements.

Age: Your dog must be at least 16 weeks old to attend Doggy Town. At our discretion once your dog reaches six months old, he must be neutered and female dogs must not come to daycare while in season to participate in Doggy Town.

Attendance: At Doggy Town is at our discretion and we reserve the right to decide if Doggy Town is not a good fit for a dog, based on medical condition or other factors. Please disclose all medical conditions when you enquire about Doggy Town. We reserve the right to turn away dogs at check-in or contact you to pick up your dog if it is determined that Doggy Town is not an appropriate option for your dog.

Behavior: Your dog's acceptance into Doggy Town is at the sole discretion of the staff. If your dog is disruptive while at Doggy Town you may be called to pick up your dog. Your dog will not be able to return until the problem is resolved.

Risk and Responsibility: Your dog's attendance at Doggy Town is not without risk. Every effort will be made by the staff to provide a safe environment for all dogs; however, Doggy Town is not responsible for any injury sustained by you or your dog while on the premises. If your dog requires emergency medical attention, we will contact you immediately and transport your dog to your veterinarian or the after-hours, on-call veterinarian. You will be responsible for all charges incurred. You are responsible for any damage or injury caused by your dog or the actions of your dog, including but not limited to: veterinary costs, hospital costs, and property damage. Vet charges due to injury to your dog or injury to another dog caused by your dog will be the responsibility of you and the owner of the other dog. We are not responsible for any injuries to or loss of your dog due to jumping out of kennels or play areas or digging under the fences. All dogs must be leashed while on property, including travel between the car and the building.

Charges and Fees: All dogs must be picked up by 6pm. Current rates are posted in the office.

I, the undersigned, agree to the above, accept full responsibility for the acts of my dog while at Doggy Town and release Doggy Town and its staff, board or directors, and volunteers from any and all claims of liability.
